These design guidelines cover most situations for normal applications. Because of the myriad of application types, there may be specific situations that are not handled here. If an example or guideline is not available or does not cover the specific situation, the programmer should try to stay in the same spirit as the existing guidelines. In a case that differentiates greatly from the spirit of the guidelines, a group meeting should be held to discuss the proper appearance.

Placement of Controls

Forms should generally be laid out in order of functional operation, and then follow a left to right, up and down layout pattern. Controls and group boxes should be aligned to the left side of each other. In a properly designed form, the order of operation is apparent to the user based on the layout of the controls.

Controls on the forms (buttons, labels, edit boxes, list boxes, etc.) should be placed into functional groups and surrounded by group boxes so that the grouping is visually apparent to the user. However, you should only use group boxes when necessary and not waste resources when they are not necessary. Sets of Radio buttons should always be constructed using RadioGroup boxes. If check boxes relate to each other, they should be surrounded by a group box or placed on a panel.

The tab order of the form should follow the flow of the form and help accommodate the order in which data needs to be entered. When the form is first displayed, the focus should be placed on the first control that needs attention on the form. Usually either a button or an edit control, depending on the forms content.

The preferred format for labels and edit controls is a vertical placement aligned along the left sides. (This means that the label is placed above the edit control it is related to.) The label should not be more than 8 pixels above the edit control and not be closer than 3 pixels. It is acceptable to use 2 labels and break extremely long text onto the two lines when necessary.

Example of Edit Box Coloring

In certain situations it is acceptable to use alternative colors to bring the attention of specific data items to the users. These alternatives should be consistently applied throughout the application and radical alternations in the color patterns should be discussed with the group.

About Boxes and Splash Screens

Every application must have an about box that is selected by choosing the About menu item off of the Help menu. This dialog should display the name of the application, the version number, the version date, and the Grand Casinos copyright. The about box will not display the developers name directly on the screen, but 'easter eggs' may be programmed to display the developers names as long as the 'easter egg' is not extremely large, affects the application adversely, or displays derogatory statements.

If the application takes more than 6 seconds to load on a normal machine, then it must have a Splash Screen. The Splash Screen should be the standard splash screen dialog located in the SHARE directory.

Application Icons and Titles

Every application will have an application icon different from the default Delphi icon assigned to it. The icon should be descriptive of what the application does and should remain consistent for multiple versions. This means that cartoon and logo icons are not permitted. A library of icons is available in the SHARE directory.
